

#### 1 INTRODUCTION & WELCOME

Welcome to the BP Ultimate Rally Raid Portugal!

With unique conditions for cross-country competitions, Portugal is hosting a World Rally Raid Championship event for the first time, the only one held in Europe.

Stunning landscapes, a passionate public and a challenging race await you between 2 and 7 April.

With its operational base in Grândola, where the race control, teams and drivers are concentrated, it will also be the venue for the prologue.

The rally is expected to be tough, taking part in the tracks of Alentejo, Ribatejo (Portugal) and Extremadura (Spain) over 1720 kilometres of high competition, much to the delight of the fans who will be able to watch the cars, motorbikes and drivers perform along the route.

The BP Ultimate Rally Raid Portugal is eligible for the FIA and FIM World Rally Raid Championships, as well as for the Portuguese Cross-Country Championship.



A word of thanks to all the municipalities involved in the rally route (Grândola, Santiago do Cacém, Abrantes, Alcácer do Sal, Almeirim, Chamusca, Coruche, Mação, Ponte de Sor, Salvaterra de Magos and Sines) and for the indispensable support of the sponsors - BP and M. Eletricity, Catering, Toilets & showers and first aid post (24 hours a day).

There are petrol stations, supermarkets and car washes in the vicinity of the Bivouac.



- It is forbidden to use the mobile phone while driving.




