



Bivouac Grândola

- In Portugal and Spain, we drive on the right.
- Exceeding the maximum speed limits may result in the withdrawal of the driving licence, in addition to a cash sanction.
- It is expressly forbidden to drive in Portugal and Spain with an alcohol level in the blood equal or superior to 0.50 gr/l. Authorities may decide the immediate immobilization of the vehicle.
- It is compulsory for drivers and passengers to wear seat belts always.
- It is forbidden to use the mobile phone while driving.




