1 INTRODUCTION & WELCOME

Welcome to BP Ultimate Rally-Raid Portugal!

With unique conditions for cross-country competitions, Portugal is once again hosting the only World Rally-Raid Championship event held in Europe. The debut in 2024, with a large crowd and fascinating stages, was a huge success.

And it's going to be a challenging event that awaits you between 22 and 28 September. With its operational base in Grândola, where the race directors, teams and drivers are concentrated, it is also the place where the Prologue will be held.
